Guidelines for Quilt Entries 2013

We applaud and encourage the sewing methods of old traditional quilt making.

1. Only two quilt entries per person may be submitted due to space limitations.
2. Submitted quilt must have been completed within 3 years of the show.
Previously entered quilts but not winning a ribbon may be entered again.
3. No previous ribbon winners accepted - ribbon winner quilts may be used for display.
4. Antique Quilts must be 50 years or older. It is as old as its newest component.
5. Quilts that are top pieced by **one** person then quilted by **one** other person can be entered with **both** names.
6. Best of Show – Must be hand quilted, embroidered and/or appliquéd
(No fusing of fabric)
7. Machine Quilting – Quilts with machine work on the squares and/or machine top quilted will be entered in this category. These do not include the Share Square Friendship Quilts.
8. Shared Square Friendship Bed Quilts
These shared squares are made by hand and/or machine by many different quilters. It is nice to have the public know that many quilters contributed squares to the finished quilt.

QUILT CATEGORIES

1. **Hand Quilted Bed Quilts:** The entire quilt must be completely hand quilted.
2. **Appliquéd by Hand Bed Quilts:** All appliquéd work must be done by hand.
3. **Embroidered by Hand Bed Quilts:** All embroidery must be done by hand.

4. **Machine Quilted Bed Quilts:** A bed quilt that is made using any machine technique quilting, appliqué, piecing, and/or embroidery.
5. **Baby Quilt:** This includes hand work and/or machine work. Crib size or smaller will be accepted and must be for baby (no teen or juvenal themes).
6. **Wall Hangings, Lap Quilts, and Table Runners:** This includes hand quilting and/or machine technique quilting, appliqué, piecing, and/or embroidery.
7. **Shared Friendship Bed Quilt:** May represent squares made by several quilters but pieced and completed by one person or a quilt pieced by one person and hand quilted by more than one person.
8. **Quilt Projects:** Must be made using **quilting** techniques: piecing, handwork and/or machine.
(example:
jackets, kitchen quilts, tote bags, vests, pocketbooks, place mats, pillows, pillow shams, small item group project, etc.
9. **Antique Quilt:** 50 years or older.
10. **Best of Show:** A submitted Bed Quilt, Baby Quilt, Wall Hanging, Table Runner or Lap Quilt that is hand worked. No machine stitching showing

Works in progress may be shown if there is room.
